

Aliases

- The alias command allows you to define new commands. Useful for creating shortcuts for longer commands. The syntax is.

```
alias alias-name=executed_command
```

Some examples:

```
alias m=more  
alias rm="rm -i"  
alias h="history -r | more"
```

To view all current aliases:

```
alias
```

To remove a previously defined alias:

```
unalias alias_name
```
